PRICES: Based on present market conditions and are subject to change without notice. All prices are F.O.B. from Canby, Oregon.

TERMS: Net due in 30 days. A service charge of (1.5%) per month or an annual percentage rate of eighteen percent (18%) on all overdue accounts. There will be a (3%) processing charge added for all payments made by credit card.

INSPECTION CERTIFICATES: Furnished with each shipment.

DISPUTES: Oregon law shall govern all of the terms and provisions of our contract. In the event a dispute arises as to the enforcement of any of the terms or provisions of this contract, Speer & Sons Nursery, Inc. shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorney fees incurred, regardless of whether or not a legal action is instituted.

ORDERS: All orders are booked subject to crop conditions, error in counts, and with the understanding that the same shall be void should injury befall the stock because of hail, frost, or other causes beyond our control.

All cancellations or changes must be submitted in writing before December 1, 2025. All cancellations after December 1, 2025 will be subject to a 15% restocking fee.

SHIPPING: When ordering please give definite shipping instructions as to how and when you want your nursery stock sent. All purchase orders should include your phone number and fax number. We use refrigerated trucks for all of our shipments.

CLAIMS: Any claims or complaints must be made within 10 days upon receipt of shipment. Any stock rejected must be reported immediately and must be held for our advice or disposition. We will gladly make adjustments when such claims are established.


